



Charlotte Mann Wall Drawings

Charlotte Mann (1977 -) is a British artist known for 1:1 scale wall drawings. She draws imaginary objects and domestic scenes with black marker pen on to white walls.

She works with simple linear drawings. Most of her works have served as backdrops for various events, like fashion shows, but she has also unleashed her artistic talents on living spaces, working on commission in people's homes. For her impressive drawn murals, Charlotte Mann uses a special water-based marker called the **Posca** marker pen, which is non toxic. This prevents her from feeling light-headed from the fumes, during long drawing sessions.
